## New '7-star' hotel for Dubai

Plans are in the works for a new Dhs1.8bn 'seven star' offshore hotel in Dubai that will only be accessible via helicopter or boat, reported Emirates Today. The hotel, which will be located on a man-made island about 400 meters off of Dubai's coast, will feature private lagoons, an underwater restaurant, and a butterfly jungle.
